Academics

- Admissions Requirements
 - A sample of your work in the field you are pursuing is required to apply.
 - Application approval from Alma College prior to submission: you are required to print out your application for administrator to review & approve
- Program Academics
 - 15 week academic program with focus on performing, visual & media arts, arts administration, and writing & publishing.
 - Students receive academic credit from Ohio Wesleyan University (OWU)
 - Alma College Department Chairs determine credit awarded. Below are the OWU credits awarded as of Fall 2018; please review the New York Arts program website for potential changes

- Fall Semester, Spring Semester, and Summer: All of these terms fulfill the "S" course requirement.
- Spring Semester and Summer: Only fulfills "S" Spring Term course requirement if program runs through May. At this time, neither the Spring Semester nor Summer Program take place in May. If that changes in the future, a student would need to confirm and get approval with the Registrar once the program dates are published.

Housing

- Housing is through Education Housing Services, in the historic New Yorker Hotel at 481 Eighth Avenue, NYC. The New Yorker is conveniently located in the heart of midtown.
- Students provide their own food and cooking utensils. Dining areas are provided, and kitchens are equipped with state of the art appliances: stoves, refrigerators and microwaves.
